



RECOGNISING SIGNS OF A SEIZURE

Symptoms vary for each person but may include:



Movement

Repetitive, uncontrolled or jerking, or loss of movement



Speech

Difficulty speaking or unusual sounds



Senses

Sensory changes - smell, sound, vision, taste



Eyes

Staring or unusual eye movements



Consciousness

Altered or loss of consciousness



Behaviour

Changes in emotion or unusual behaviour, signs of confusion
